Students in Years 7 and 8 complete the following programme of careers advice and support in a 25 minute tutor group session each week. Plans for each of these sessions can be viewed separately. This programme is taught by class tutors and planned by the Heads of Year 7 and 8 who are the school careers leads.

In addition to this programme students will participate in at least one meaningful encounter with an employer; at least one of these encounters will be with a STEM employer or workplace.

In 2018 - 2019 these encounters will include:

- a. Careers events such as careers talks, visiting speakers, careers carousels and careers fairs.
 - *Year 8 pupils will attend a Careers Fair – The Big Bang run by Dorset LA at Bovington Tank Museum in March 2019*
- b. Business games and enterprise competitions.
 - *The school plans to provide the opportunity to take part in the Virgin Money - £5 Make it grow initiative in the Summer term for pupils in year 7.*
