As a rights respecting level 1 school, we make an effort so all our children are educated about the rights they have and their responsibilities to ensure these rights can exist. They have been taught how to treat each other well and how they as individuals should be treated.

The key articles that we enforce, as a school, are: 1, 3, 12, 13, 14, 15, 17, 19, 23, 24, 28, 29, 30, 31, 36, 42 (look online to find out what they are).

At Lockyer's, we try to include these rights into our well planned lessons. We also use these rights as a way to keep your child/children safe, happy, and educated. We suggest that you watch Newsround with your child after school as this would enforce article 17 - the right to information-.

Article 12 group is a collection of students who create ideas to help our school improve and to gain our rights respecting levels.
